We *thought* we were going to be nesters. One thing that makes our Kenya move hard is that Linda was already in the nesting-for-retirement stage when the Lord called us. Now we are moving to Kijabe, Kenya where no housing is available. So we have to build a new nest.

We're not building just for ourselves, but for the missionaries who will live in the house while we are on home assignment, and for the missionaries who will live in the house for decades to come when we are gone.

You can think of it as the "Little House on the rim of the Great Rift Valley." The picture above is the most recently built home in Kijabe. Our home will not be as large, but will be similar in construction and style. The house we will build will be home to us while we are away from you. It will be a center of our ministry to Moffat students and alumni. It will be a place of welcome for you when you come visit us.

So we are building not just for ourselves, but for future missionaries and many others, including you, perhaps.

It takes about five months to build a cinder block house (see the picture) using local wafundi (stone workers). Having a place to live when we arrive in Kijabe will require construction starting in September. Construction can't start until we have \$20,000 in our housing project fund. The total cost of the house will be \$35-40,000.00 (compare that with US housing costs!) but AIM Kenya is only asking us to come up with \$20,000 to \$30,000.

Some of you have said that you can't make a regular monthly commitment now, but would like to make occasional or one-time gifts to us. This essential project needs attention now, and would be a great place to put one or two of those occasional gifts. But whether or not the Lord leads you to help financially, please pray that: - the money will come in at the right time, -the house will be built to suit the needs of all who will live there (Linda especially wants lots of outside light), - the building process will go smoothly and safely.

If you feel led to help, you can send your check to us, made out to Africa Inland Mission and enclose a note that it is for housing. Thanks so much for your help.
